

Juvenile Justice Intervention Center

- Pretrial detention for juvenile offenders
- Orleans Parish; Urban area
- Budget from 2021-2023: \$22, 610, 183
- Capacity of 76 beds
- Run by Sheriff Susan Hutson since 2021, replacing long time Sheriff Marlin Gusman
- 2019- Juveniles barricaded themselves inside the JJIC, and the NOPD Special Operations Division was called in.
- 2021- During Hurricane Ida, detainees were evacuated into an adult facility in violation of both federal and state laws that prohibit detained juveniles to be housed with convicted adults.
- 2022- Four detainees escaped the facility. Dr. Kyshun Webster resigned as Executive Director after a report detailing the misuse of funds(including the use of funds for his dog (pictured), Lacy's veterinarian visits), constant absenteeism, misuse of city property (housing his dog in the jail), abuse of office (instructing employees to take his dog to the veterinarian and watching the dog while on duty), and verbally abusing city employees.
