GENERAL APPEARANCE/CLEANLINESS/COMMENTS OF THE FACILITY:

Living Area:

Housing areas are neat and clean and free of pests and odors.

Dorms:

The area used for a dorm where the trustees are assigned is clean. All offenders have a mattress with sheets and blankets on their bed. Beds were made up with offender belongings stored properly.

Cell Block:

The cells are used to house pre-trial offenders. The cells are clean. Offenders housed in the cells were very quiet during the walk through. Offenders were seen watching tv.

Culinary/Dining:

The jail does not have a dining room or kitchen. The meals are prepared at Catahoula Correctional Center and delivered to the parish jail. The jailer then issues out the food trays to the offenders housed. All three meals are delivered from the correctional facility.

Bathrooms:

Bathroom area is clean. Adequate hot water available for offender use. Hot water temperatures are checked daily.

Yard Areas:

The yard consist of a concrete slab area surrounded by a fence. The area was clean. The yard area has a few weight benches for offenders to utilize for recreation.

Maintenance:

The maintenance department has a caged area locked with tools stored. All tools are on a shadow board and are on inventory and signed in and out. Building maintenance is done through the Police Jury.

REVIEW AND COMMENT ON THE FOLLOWING BASIC JAIL GUIDELINES: (Compliant or Non-Compliant)

I-A-001 Safety/Sanitation/Inspections- Compliant

Daily inspections being done of the jail. DHH and FM last inspections were done in 2019. No DHH or FM inspections done in 2020 due to COVID. The Warden is waiting on inspections to be conducted for 2021.

I-C-001 Emergency Plan-Compliant

The jail has an emergency plan in place. Employees are trained in emergency procedures. The emergency plans have been submitted to the Fire Marshal and approved in 2020. The evacuations plans have not been yet submitted for 2021 for approval by the Fire Marshal office.

II-A-007 Counts- Compliant

- How many formal counts are conducted each shift? Minimum of 2 formal counts
- How many counts are conducted each day? Minimum 4 counts per day

Stick outs are counts that are conducted in areas other than housing units, such as food services and other areas of normally authorized locations. When conducting and submitting the counts, employees are to actually see the offender before turning in theses counts.

- How does the facility accomplish this? Work details are counted by the officer in charge of the detail and called into the jailer for appropriate count times.
- Does this process insure accountability and safe/secure operation of the facility? Yes

II-A-008 Offender Population Management System-Compliant Master prison records, bill of information, finger prints, photos are kept on offenders housed at the jail.

II-A-010 Admissions-Compliant Offender property and belongings searched and stored upon intake. Offender are provided with health screen information and offender handbook.

Transfers are done according to BJG guidelines. A letter in file stating there has been no transfers from the jail as of the date of the audit for 2021.

II-A-020 Frequency of Cell Checks-Compliant

Officers make rounds every 30 to 45 minutes in the jail. If an offender is on some type of watch then officers make rounds every 15 minutes. If an offender is on watch he is sent to the Catahoula Correctional Center and not kept at the jail.

II-B-002-1 Use of Restraints for Pregnant Offenders-N/A

Jail does not house female offenders.

II-C-001 Procedures for Searches-Compliant

Offenders and their property are being searched by officers. Offenders are searched after going out on work details or work crews.

II-D-001 Key, Tool and Utensil Control-Compliant

Keys are being logged in log books by the jailers working on shift. Tools are being signed in and out properly and on inventory. The jail does not have a kitchen so therefore have no utensils.

Facility has offender handbook that is given during intake process.

- What is their restoration of good time application process for the offender population? Offenders will fill out the form for the restoration of good time and send to the sheriff or administrator at the facility. Once reviewed and approved then it is sent to Headquarters.
