

RE: "Basic Jail Guidelines" Monitoring Report

Please see the attached monitoring report regarding the Basic Jail Guidelines (BJG) annual inspection that was conducted at Concordia Parish Correctional Facility on April 27, 2022. During the walk through of the living area there were a few areas of concern;

- Dorm - Offender property, belongings, etc. hanging from beds, under mattresses, and on the floor.
- Cellblock - There were cells with several empty Styrofoam food trays and trash, cells were being cleaned at time of inspection and a few cells were in needs of painting.
- Bathrooms - Were in need of cleaning and painting.

Although, Concordia Parish Correctional Facility continues to provide a secure, safe, and stable environment for DOC offenders, DPS&C would like to encourage full compliance with BJG II-A-018 "Offender Drug Testing", and III-A-001 "Rules and Discipline", as well as addressing the general appearance and cleanliness of the facility as noted above.

At this time, DPS&C will continue with annual monitoring. Thank you for your support of the BJG process.

GENERAL APPEARANCE, CLEANLINESS, AND COMMENTS OF THE FACILITY:

Living Area:

- **Dorms** – The dorms and living areas are in need of some cleaning. Cleaning supplies were being passed out during the audit. All offender beds have mattresses with sheets and blankets. Offender property and belongings were hanging from some of the beds and under mattresses or on the floor.
- **Cell Block** – The lockdown cells were being cleaned at the time of the inspection. There were cells with several empty Styrofoam food trays and trash that were left in the cells that was being picked up.

during the audit. There was an offender in a cell what was on a mental health observation. Documentation of rounds made were noted. Some painting needed in lockdown cells.

Culinary/Dining:

The facility does not have a dining hall. The food is prepared and placed in food carts and sent out to the living units for distribution. The kitchen area was clean. Food in coolers and dry storage areas are dated and stored properly. Cooler, freezer and hot water temperatures for the dishwasher are checked and recorded. Kitchen utensils are in a locked cabinet on a shadow board and all on inventory. Utensils are being signed in and out.

Bathrooms:

The bathrooms are in need of some cleaning and in working condition. Shower walls and floors can use cleaning. Hot water available for employee and offender use. There is some paint peeling in the shower areas throughout the jail. All the metal sheeting in the showers from last year's inspection has been removed. ?

Yard Areas:

The yard area is clean. Offenders were observed outside on the yard for recreation during the audit.

Maintenance:

The maintenance and mechanic departments are clean and kept up neatly. All tools are in a tool room and on a shadow board and on a master inventory. Tools are signed in and out properly. Supplies stored in the flammable cabinet is accurate and Safety Data Sheets on hand for products stored.

REVIEW AND COMMENT ON THE FOLLOWING BASIC JAIL GUIDELINES: (Compliant or Non-Compliant)

I-A-001 Safety/Sanitation/Inspections- Compliant- Safety and sanitation inspections are conducted throughout the facility. FM inspection was done on 1/28/22 with no deficiencies noted but over capacity on that day. Facility reduced the population to be in compliance with capacity. DHH inspections were done on 6/8/21 with no violations for the facility and one notation on the inspection for the kitchen that was corrected on site (COS) .

I-C-001 Emergency Plan- Compliant- The jail has an emergency plan/policy to handle emergency situations that may arise. The emergency plans have been updated and submitted to the FM and awaiting on approval for 2022.

II-A-007 Counts- Compliant- Counts being conducted according to policy.

- How many formal counts are conducted each shift? 4 counts day shift, 5 counts night shift
- How many counts are conducted each day? 9 counts each day
- **Stick outs counts** are counts that are conducted in areas other than housing units, such as food services and other areas of normally authorized locations. When conducting and submitting the counts, employees are to actually see the offender before turning in theses counts.
 - How does the facility accomplish this? Offenders are physically counted when not in housing units for count time and count called in to control.
 - Does this process insure accountability and safe/secure operation of the facility? Yes

II-A-008 Offender Population Management System- Compliant- Master prison record, fingerprints, photo ID for each offender is kept on file. Plan allows for a safe and secure housing of offenders.
